Tia Kemokai is the owner of Tiangay Kemokai Law, P.C. Based on her experience in international criminal law, she continues to apply her knowledge of restorative justice principles to various aspects of her practice. She believes that restorative justice principles that have been successfully applied in matters of peace and war and life and death can be utilized to achieve healthy, diverse communities.

Ms. Kemokai has combined her experience in state and federal discrimination jurisprudence and restorative justice principles to create a unique, premiere DEI training and certification program that will be digitally platformed for maximum access. To that end, she currently provides a wide array of DEI services with a focus on restorative remediation, which is a phrase she coined to address the adverse impact that discrimination has on workplace environments and communities writ large.
